




A SPACE ODYSSEY*

Welcome to Oakridge Summer Camp! We are excited that you will be joining us for week 3: "A Space Odyssey". The camp staff has planned a week that is full of cosmic adventure and entertainment! Get ready for an out-of-this-world journey as we learn about space exploration and the people who have made it possible.

On **Monday**, our space cadets will travel to unknown galaxies and worlds unknown as we learn about the constellations and create a few of their own. **A NASA Astronaut** will zoom in for a visit, explain light-years, and share his space stories with us. Our Owl Professor will come by to share his expertise about rockets.

On **Tuesday**, each cabin will create its own galaxy and design a planet. This imaginary planet will have its own life form, atmosphere and other cosmic properties. Everyone will find a moon crater full of water to take a dazzling dip! Be sure to bring your swim suit and towel. 1st – 4th grade campers will swim at Mrs. G's pool and younger campers will do water play in the courtyard.

On **Wednesday**, we'll have a "*Rocketfest*" and learn all about rockets. Campers will visit our own space lab to perform experiments and record data just like NASA. 3 & 4 year olds and Kindergarten campers will enjoy a visit from *a special space creature* and participate in "*Reach for the Stars*". 1st – 4th graders will travel to the *UTA Planetarium*.

On **Thursday**, campers will learn about telling time with the sun. Each cabin will make a sundial. We'll do experiments about gravity and solar eclipses. Bring your swim suit and towel for a sunny swim or water play!

On **Friday**, everyone should come dressed like their favorite astronaut or space creature. We'll celebrate "*ASTRONAUT DAY*" with a game of trivia and launch an astronaut parade. Be sure to bring your clues to show "the right stuff". We will have a cosmic talent show so start preparing your act. Older campers will travel to *Alley Cats* for an out of this world adventure!

Each day will offer campers arts and crafts, games and information related to our great solar system. Remember to bring a lunch and drink each day. Snacks will be served in the morning and afternoon.

We'll see you bright and early Monday morning, June 24. Camp begins at 9 am and ends at 3:30 pm. Campers can be dropped off in the carpool line beginning at 8:45 am. Counselors will assist them out of the car and into the building. You may walk them into the building if you wish. Extended Day opens at 8:00 am and closes at 5:30 pm. Please walk campers into the building if they come for morning Extended Day.
